NEW MEXICO CHILES 1991

TEAM HISTORY: The New Mexico Chiles are a product of five years of evolution in the New Mexico community. Five years ago, Albuquerque witnessed the birth of the Albuquerque Outlaws in the SISL. The Outlaws changed their name to the Albuquerque Gunners and played under that name until 1989. Under new management, the Gunners were renamed the New Mexico Roadrunners in 1990. The New Mexico Chiles are an outdoor team that began play in the APSL last season. Despite drawing over 5,000 fans per game, the Chiles found themselves without a league to play in when the APSL West folded. The obvious solution to this problem was this season's merger between the SISL Roadrunners and New Mexico Chiles.

OWNERSHIP/MANAGEMENT: The franchise is owned by Joe Shealy, but is operated in the outdoor season by the Players Soccer Corporation, a corporation formed by New Mexico Chiles players and headed by President Gregory Rusk. John Renken fills the role of Vice President and David Robertson is the Secretary.

COACHING: Returning to lead the Chiles from the bench will be Czech born Vilem "Czecho" Ryba. The former Czechoslovakian professional is no stranger to the Chile

players. Ryba coached the Albuquerque Gunners to their best indoor season in 1987-88 and an appearance in the Mitre/Soccer America National Indoor Championship.

PLAYERS: The New Mexico Chiles roster is full of players with previous SISL experience. Former players of both the Outlaws and Gunners include midfielder David Robertson, forward Ronni Banks, and defenders Gregory Rusk and John Renken. In goal will be New Mexico Chiles returning keeper Dana Rogge and former Memphis Rogue and Tucson Amigo Jorge Valenzuela. At defense will be former Roadrunner Steve Farer, and former Gunner Tommy Smith. Also returning is former Gunner, Colorado Comet and two time SISL Defender of the Year Steve Famiglietta.

At midfield will be five time SISL All Star Enrique Serrano, a veteran of the Gunners, Colorado Comets, and the Tucson Amigos. The forward line will be made up of former Gunner and Lubbock Lazer Uwe Blazis, Rod Underwood, formerly of the Atlanta Attack, and Vladdy Stanojevic, the leading forward of last summer's Chiles squad.

OUTLOOK: The New Mexico Chiles have talent, experience and fanatical support - three factors that traditionally translate into success.
